SYNOPSIS SUMMARY

This is the saga of PC Sara Weston. Clumsy, bespectacled, nerdy, needy with a side of desperate. With only a cat for company and a love life as barren as the Sahara, she's lost everything that ever mattered to her, clinging onto her job like an ex, taking the house and kids! But don't be fooled; Sara's more lethal than she looks. We join Sara as she limps back to work after a catastrophic incident that left her partner dead meat, and herself, a chew toy for someone – or something, quite unholy. Wrestling with PTSD and nightmares featuring her faceless assailant, she stumbles through her daily grind, not coping well - unless you count crying in the bathroom, and rocking back and forth seeing hallucinations as a coping strategy.

As time pushes on, a surprise - Sara's been infected by her mystery attacker! She keeps this little detail hush-hush, but the infection isn't your run-of-the-mill type sniffle. She starts behaving oddly as her senses turn up to eleven. Catching a bullet in her hand during a robbery? Check. Punching through a car door to save a woman from a fiery demise? Check. Jumping over garden fences when chasing a criminal? Check. Sniffing out drugs in a car! Check! Naturally, this doesn't go unnoticed, and the wrong sort of people start taking an interest. By the end of the first episode, Sara's wandering around in a daze, halfway to becoming a full-blown werewolf! As if this weren't enough of a buzzkill, she's haunted by her very-dead ex-partner, PC Sam "Fergie" Fergusson, who's hell-bent on dragging her to the afterlife where she belongs. Her only saving grace? Her psychotic, foul-mouthed friend Mandy, the lone dwindling thread keeping her tethered to some sort of sanity.

Throughout the series, Sara grapples with the beast she's becoming while hunting down the creature that caused this mayhem. She's got a demon growing inside of her now and Karl, her new, unlucky partner to break in. Each episode sees her using her freakish abilities to play supercop, edging closer to unmasking the monster who turned her life upside down. The twist? The rogue werewolf that attacked her is part of a secret society of creatures who just want to live in peace without all the pesky human judgment and persecution. Sara's loyalties get murkier than a curry house bathroom as she faces the ultimate choice: live among humans or embrace the new underworld of her supernatural kin.
